WEBINAR DESCRIPTION:

Antibiotic use in long-term care has come under intense scrutiny due in part to studies which suggested they are overused and poorly managed. Misuse of antibiotics can have profound clinical implications for the residents who receive them and adversely affect the "regulatory health" of the facilities who administer them. This presentation, given by a board certified geriatric pharmacist and the former Chief Nurse of Maryland's state survey agency, will provide an overview of current and pending federal regulations which impact antibiotic use. Best clinical practices designed to reduce the risks associated with antibiotics will also be explored. Finally, antibiotic stewardship will be discussed from both a clinical and operational perspective.
